# HELP IMPROVE MELANOMA TREATMENTS Participate in a clinical trial

The Melanoma Margins Trial (MelMarT-II) is looking at whether reducing the amount of skin

removed during surgery can improve quality of life and reduce the risk of melanoma returning.

Almost **3,000 participants** will join the trial from Australia, New Zealand, North America, Europe, and the UK.

### Am I eligible?

Participants must be 18 years or older and have been diagnosed with primary cutaneous melanoma. Additional criteria applies.

#### What's involved in the trial?

Participants will be monitored in accordance with their surgical team's standard of care. Follow-up assessments will occur 3, 6, and 12 months after surgery and then annually for up to 10 years.

#### Why should I join MelMarT-II?

This practice-changing study aims to further medical knowledge and potentially improve future treatment of melanoma.
