



HELP IMPROVE MELANOMA TREATMENTS

Participate in a clinical trial

The Melanoma Margins Trial (MelMarT-II) is looking at whether reducing the amount of skin removed during surgery can improve quality of life and reduce the risk of melanoma returning.

Almost **3,000 participants** will join the trial from Australia, New Zealand, North America, Europe, and the UK.

Am I eligible?

Participants must be 18 years or older and have been diagnosed with primary cutaneous melanoma. Additional criteria applies.

What's involved in the trial?

Participants will be monitored in accordance with their surgical team's standard of care. Follow-up assessments will occur 3, 6, and 12 months after surgery and then annually for up to 10 years.

Why should I join MelMarT-II?

This practice-changing study aims to further medical knowledge and potentially improve future treatment of melanoma.
