Connect with renowned leaders in melanoma and skin cancer clinical trials to learn about emerging discoveries and foster collaboration in cutting-edge research.

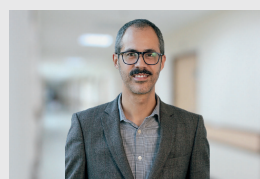
Who should attend?
